Member Guest Policy

October 2023

Below are the rules that have been approved for members bringing guests to the club.

First these rules apply to all Life, Emeritus, or General members; referred to as 'member' below. Spousal members are **NOT** allowed to bring guests.

1. The definition of a guest is:
 - a. Any person over the age of twenty-one (21) as of January 1st of the current year.
 - b. Or, any person, regardless of age that is not a child, grandchild, sibling, or person under guardianship of a member.
2. The limit set for guests is two (2) on club property not just on a range.
 - a. The card holding member is the only person allowed to have guests. A member's family is **NOT** allowed to have separate guests.
 - b. This limit is **NOT** applicable to people shooting at an approved and organized or public shooting event listed on the club's website.
3. The guests are the responsibility of the club member, and the member is accountable for their actions.
4. The member must sign-in with the Range Safety Officer (RSO) at the range building and disclose the number of guests they have with them before being assigned a range.
5. Each guest must sign a waiver available in the range building. For guests under the age of eighteen (18) the waiver needs to be signed by a custodial parent or legal guardian.
6. It is required for each guest to pay a \$5.00 daily fee to use the rifle / pistol or archery ranges. This fee is paid to the RSO or into the yellow tube found near the range building or on the shooting line of the archery range.
